


An outpouring of God's Love & Compassion

Timeline

You may remember that Akin last visited Nigeria in November 2016 where he held 2 events to distribute food to the aged and OAPs. One of these events in Ogbomosho saw us blessing 283 people and the other in Saki blessing 253 people. The pictures below show the crowd in both places.









Since then, Toro has visited Nigeria on a praying trip, soaking the land in prayer and preparing the place spiritually for what God has in store to achieve through our three-dimensional partnership; you as supporter, giver and sender; us as missionaries, planters and goers and Him as He who blesses our efforts with untold success!

More importantly it has recently been agreed by the ECC leadership team that Toro and I will be officially commissioned to Nigeria as missionaries. We, together with the leadership are currently working out a transition from my current role in the office to my role in Nigeria, ensuring that the administration of the church continues to run smoothly.

We have also enrolled on the Elim's Missions Academy, the successful completion of which will mean that we are recognised, not just by our local church ECC as missionaries, but indeed accredited by the Elim movement as missionaries.

It has therefore been both an exciting and challenging time when we consider the magnitude of what we have committed ourselves to. The plan is for Akin to depart and be stationed in Nigeria as an Elim missionary early in 2018 and for Toro to join me around May 2018.

To answer God's call therefore, not only are we prepared to leave our home and children here in the UK as well as to leave our comfort zone, but Toro is having to leave her job. We therefore ask that you continue to pray for us, for the confidence to trust God, for our home and children in the UK and for our finances!



We are grateful and indebted that you have taken on this great ministry of sending us as missionaries and pray that together we shall accomplish God's will.
